By application filed February 14, 1991, Monica Mills, Brenda Williams, and Larry Williams, a Partnership, trading as MONCHEN'E (MONCHEN'E or applicant) seek a Certificate of Authority to transport passengers in irregular route operations between points in the Metropolitan District.

By application filed February 20, 1991, MONCHEN'E also seeks temporary authority to transport passengers in irregular route operations between points in the Metropolitan District for the account of the Federal Highway Administration of the United States Department of Transportation.

By Order Nos. 3610 and 3614, served February 20 and February 22, 1991, respectively, notice of these applications was given. Order No. 3610 required MONCHEN'E to publish notice of the application for a Certificate of Authority no later than February 28, 1991. Applicant will be directed to file proof of such publication. The deadline for filing protests to the application for temporary authority was March 4, 1991. The deadline for filing protests to the application for a Certificate of Authority was March 22, 1991.

Taking official notice of the Commission's records, it is noted that by order of the United States District Court for the District of Columbia, Mr. Larry Williams, one of MONCHEN'E's partners and the person listed as its representative, is currently enjoined from transporting passengers for hire between points in the Metropolitan District. It is also noted that a protest to Case No. AP-91-10, alleging such operations, has been filed. In light of the facts and pursuant to the Compact, Title II, Article XI, Sections 7 and 13, and Article XIII, the above-captioned matters will be scheduled for public hearing to determine (1) whether applicant is fit, willing, and able to perform the proposed transportation and (2) whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest. These two

applications will be consolidated for public hearing. Applicant will be assessed an amount preliminarily estimated to cover the costs of hearing pursuant to the Compact, Title II, Article XIV.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That a public hearing in Case Nos. AP-91-10 and AP-91-11 is hereby scheduled to commence Wednesday, April 24, 1991, at 10:00 a.m. in the Hearing Room of the Commission, 1828 L Street, N.W., Suite 703, Washington, DC 20036-5104.

2. That Monica Mills, Brenda Williams, and Larry Williams, a Partnership, trading as MONCHEN'E are hereby assessed \$750 pursuant to the Compact, Title II, Article XIV, and are directed to deliver said amount to the office of the Commission, 1828 L Street, N.W., Suite 703, Washington, DC 20036-5104, no later than Friday, April 12, 1991.

3. That Monica Mills, Brenda Williams, and Larry Williams, a Partnership, trading as MONCHEN'E are hereby directed to file, no later than Friday, April 12, 1991, proof of publication of notice, as directed by Order No. 3610, served February 20, 1991.
