

The certificate of insurance on file for Madhu Sudan trading as City Sights (Mr. Sudan) expired January 9, 1991. On January 2, 1991, Mr. Sudan filed a request for an extension of time to file a certificate of insurance. By Order No. 3596, served January 3, 1991, (1) this proceeding was instituted, (2) Mr. Sudan was named a party respondent, (3) Mr. Sudan was given until April 10, 1991, to file a certificate of insurance or other pertinent evidence why Certificate No. 145 should not be revoked, (4) Certificate No. 145 was suspended effective January 9, 1991, and (5) Mr. Sudan was provided an opportunity for oral hearing.

The time for filing a certificate of insurance or other evidence elapsed on April 10, 1991, without a filing of any type by Mr. Sudan. The time for seeking an oral hearing also elapsed without a request. Thus, pursuant to the authority of Title II, Article XI, Section 10 of the Compact, Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 145 will be revoked for failure of the holder to comply with both a lawful order and regulation of the Commission.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 145 of Madhu Sudan trading as City Sights is hereby revoked.
