By Order No. 3639, served March 25, 1991, the Commission granted an application of Rosetta D. Murray trading as Murray's Non-Emergency Transport Service to transfer WMATC Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 63 to Murray's Transportation Service, Inc. (MTS). MTS was directed to file, no later than April 24, 1991, the following:

- (a) . . . evidence of insurance pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 58 and Order No. 3623;
- (b) . . . five copies of its tariffs in accordance with Commission Regulation No. 55;
- (c) . . . an equipment list stating the make, model, serial number, vehicle number, license plate number (with jurisdiction), and seating capacity of each vehicle to be used in revenue operations in the Metropolitan District;
- (d) . . . for each vehicle to be used in revenue operations in the Metropolitan District, evidence of ownership or a lease as required by Commission Regulation No. 62; and
- (e) . . . its official business address as discussed in Commission Regulation No. 68.

Upon filing the required materials the transfer would be considered complete and WMATC Certificate No. 63 would be simultaneously transferred to its new owner (MTS) and converted to a broader Certificate of Authority pursuant to the Compact, Title II, Article XI, Section 6.

On April 11, 1991, MTS filed a certificate of insurance. On April 19, 1991, Vernon A. Williams, Esquire, counsel for Rosetta D. Murray, MTS's president and chief operating officer, filed a

motion seeking a 30-day extension of time for compliance with Order No. 3639. As grounds for the request Ms. Murray's attorney states that her participation is integral to the compliance process. However, due to an illness for which she has been hospitalized, Ms. Murray is unable to participate absent an extension of time.


In light of Order No. 3639, MTS's filing of a certificate of insurance, and the motion before the Commission, including the reasons therefor, the time for compliance with Order No. 3639 is hereby extended to May 24, 1991, and Certificate of Authority No. 63 will be issued to Murray's Transportation Service, Inc., as appended to this order.

Order No. 3600, served January 17, 1991, requires that all carriers file revised tariffs with tariff cover sheets as prescribed by Commission Regulation No. 55, no later than May 24, 1991, and Murray's Transportation Service, Inc., is so bound. In addition Murray's Transportation Service, Inc., is directed to file the following at the offices of the Commission no later than May 24, 1991: (a) an equipment list stating make, model, serial number, vehicle number, license plate number (with jurisdiction), and seating capacity of each vehicle to be used in revenue operations in the Metropolitan District; (b) for each vehicle to be used in revenue operations in the Metropolitan District, evidence of ownership or a lease in compliance with Commission Regulation No. 62; and (c) its official business address as discussed in Commission Regulation No. 68.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the motion for extension of time is hereby granted to the extent specified in the body of this order.
2. That Certificate of Authority No. 63 is hereby issued to Murray's Transportation Service, Inc., as appended to this order.
3. That Certificate of Authority No. 63 encompasses and supersedes Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 63 and any and all Authorizations under Special Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 1 and Temporary Authority issued to Rosetta D. Murray trading as Murray's Non-Emergency Transport Service.
4. That Certificate of Authority No. 63 is effective immediately.

By Order Nos. 2015, 3639, and 3705 of the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Commission issued August 7, 1979; March 25, 1991; and April 29, 1991;

WHEREAS, the above-named carrier is entitled to receive authority to transport passengers within the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit District;

THIS CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY is hereby issued to the said carrier as evidence of the authority to engage in the for-hire transportation of passengers by motor vehicle; subject, however, to such terms, conditions, and limitations as are now, or may hereafter be, attached to the exercise of the privilege granted to the said carrier:

IRREGULAR ROUTES, transporting passengers, together with mail, express, and baggage in the same vehicles as passengers, between points in the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit District;

RESTRICTED to operations conducted according to the said carrier's applicable tariff on file with the Commission; and

RESTRICTED AGAINST (1) transportation solely within the Commonwealth of Virginia and (2) any passenger transportation for hire on an individual fare paying basis in competition with any existing, scheduled, regular-route, passenger transportation service performed by, or under a contract with, the Federal Government, a signatory, or the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority.

THIS CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY DOES NOT AUTHORIZE ANY TRANSPORTATION BY ANY PERSON OTHER THAN THE CARRIER NAMED HEREON.

THIS CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY IS NOT VALID UNLESS THE CARRIER NAMED HEREON IS IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS OF THE COMMISSION.
