

By Order No. 3670, served April 10, 1991, Certificate No. 118 of The Airport Connection, Inc., II (TAC Inc. II), was suspended for failure to have on file proper evidence of insurance as required by the Compact, Title II, Article XI, Section 7(f) and Commission Regulation No. 58. This proceeding was instituted pursuant to the Compact, Title II, Article XI, Section 10 to determine whether Certificate No. 118 should be revoked. TAC Inc. II was directed within 30 days to file appropriate evidence of insurance or other evidence to show good cause why Certificate No. 118 should not be revoked.

The time for submitting a new certificate of insurance or other pertinent evidence elapsed on May 10, 1991, without a filing of any type by TAC Inc. II. */ Thus, pursuant to the authority of Title II, Article XI, Section 10 of the Compact, Certificate No. 118 will be revoked for failure to comply with both a lawful order and regulation of the Commission.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Certificate No. 118 of The Airport Connection, Inc., II, is hereby revoked.
