By Order No. 3771, served May 31, 1991, Certificate of Authority No. 31 of Ironsides Medical Transportation Corporation (IMTC) was suspended for failure of IMTC to meet the minimum insurance requirements of Regulation No. 58. This investigation was instituted, and IMTC was made a party respondent.

Among other things, Order No. 3771 provided IMTC an opportunity for hearing pursuant to the Compact, Title II, Article XI, Section 10, and directed that respondent request a hearing if one was wanted. IMTC has requested a hearing, and this order will schedule one.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That a public hearing in Case No. MP-91-22 is hereby scheduled to commence Wednesday, July 31, 1991, at 10:00 a.m. in the hearing room of the Commission, 1828 L Street, N.W., Suite 703, Washington, DC 20036-5104, for the purpose of giving Ironsides Medical Transportation Corporation an opportunity to present evidence why Certificate of Authority No. 31 should not be revoked for failure to comply with the Compact, Title II, Article XI, Section 7(f); Regulation No. 58; and Order No. 3771.

2. That pursuant to the Compact, Title II, Article XIV, Section 1, Ironsides Medical Transportation Corporation is hereby assessed the sum of \$450, an amount preliminarily estimated to cover the cost of the proceeding, and is directed to deliver that amount to the office of the Commission no later than Friday, July 19, 1991.
