By Order No. 3889, served February 20, 1992, the Commission conditionally granted the above-captioned application, contingent upon the filing of certain materials therein specified within 30 days of the date of the order.

By request filed March 11, 1992, Boatwrights Incorporated seeks "the maximum extension time allowed." In support of this request applicant states that it is "in the process of acquiring additional vehicles and they will have to be modified with non-ambulatory equipment."

Commission Regulation No. 66 provides:


Automatic Denial of Conditional Grant of Authority.

The time for compliance with the requirements for a conditional grant of authority will not be extended beyond a maximum of 180 days from the date the conditional grant of authority is issued. Such conditional grant of authority shall be considered void effective on the 181st day.

Upon consideration of applicant's request, an extension is granted through Tuesday, August 18, 1992. In the event full compliance with the requirements of Order No. 3889 is not effected on or before that date, this application will stand denied in its entirety effective Wednesday, August 19, 1992.
