By application filed May 7, 1992, William C. Dye, trading as W&D Transportation (Mr. Dye), a sole proprietor, seeks to transfer Certificate of Authority No. 61 to W&D Transportation, Inc. (WDTI or transferee), a District of Columbia corporation. Mr. Dye is a controlling shareholder of WDTI.

Certificate of Authority No. 61 authorizes Mr. Dye to transport passengers between points in the Metropolitan District, restricted to transportation in vehicles with a manufacturer's designed seating capacity of 15 or fewer persons, including the driver.

The application contains information regarding, among other things, transferee's corporate status, vehicle maintenance program, minimum requirements for drivers, finances, and regulatory compliance record. The application is available for inspection at the office of the Commission during its regular business hours.

The Compact requires the Commission to determine whether granting the transfer would be consistent with the public interest. The transferee's fitness is also at issue.

Pursuant to Rule No. 6, this order and fulfillment of its requirements will provide notice of this transfer application.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:


1. That William C. Dye, trading as W&D Transportation, shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than Friday, May 22, 1992, notice of this application in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That William C. Dye, trading as W&D Transportation, shall file with the Commission, no later than Friday, June 12, 1992, an original and four copies of an affidavit of publication as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That any person wanting to protest this application shall do so in accordance with Commission Rule No. 13 and Regulation No. 54-04(a) and any person wanting to comment on this matter, other than by protest, shall do so in writing, in accordance with Regulation No. 54-04(a), no later than Friday, June 12, 1992, and shall simultaneously serve a copy of such protest or comment on applicant, William C. Dye, 1217 Shepherd Street, N.W., Washington, DC 20011.

4. That any person seeking a formal oral hearing on this matter shall request one, in writing, in accordance with Commission Regulation No. 54-04(b), no later than Friday, June 12, 1992, and shall simultaneously serve a copy of such request on applicant, William C. Dye, 1217 Shepherd Street, N.W., Washington, DC 20011.
