
Upon consideration of the Motion For Relief filed by Madison Limousine Service, Inc., on May 8, 1992, and the Opposition To Motion For Relief filed by protestant, Air Couriers International Ground Transportation Services, Inc., on May 12, 1992, and for good cause shown,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Madison Limousine Service, Inc., shall be permitted to pay in four monthly installments of \$1,000 each, beginning May, 1992, and ending August, 1992, the \$4,000 civil forfeiture assessed in Order No. 3891, the first such installment having been received by the Commission on May 8, 1992; provided that the Commission shall not entertain any application from Madison Limousine Service, Inc., for operating authority until such time as the entire \$4,000 has been paid.

2. That the Opposition To Motion For Relief is denied in its entirety.
