By application filed June 10, 1992, Cotter Limousine of Washington, Inc. (Cotter or transferor), a Delaware corporation, seeks to amend and transfer to Carey Limousine D.C., Inc. (Carey or transferee), also a Delaware corporation, Certificate of Authority No. 69. Cotter is a wholly owned subsidiary of Carey.

Certificate of Authority No. 69 authorizes Cotter to transport passengers between points in the Metropolitan District, restricted to transportation in vehicles with a manufacturer's designed seating capacity of 15 or fewer persons, including the driver. Cotter seeks removal of that restriction, additional authority to transport baggage in the same vehicles as passengers, and transfer of the certificate, as amended, to Carey.

The application contains information regarding, among other things, transferee's corporate status, vehicle maintenance program, minimum requirements for drivers, finances, and regulatory compliance record. The application is available for inspection at the office of the Commission during its regular business hours.

The Compact requires the Commission to determine whether granting the transfer would be consistent with the public interest. The transferee's fitness is also at issue.¹

Pursuant to Commission Rule No. 6, this order and fulfillment of its requirements will provide notice of this application.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Cotter Limousine of Washington, Inc., shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than Thursday, June 18, 1992, notice of this application in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.



2. That Cotter Limousine of Washington, Inc., shall file with the Commission, no later than Thursday, July 9, 1992, an original and four copies of an affidavit of publication as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That any person wanting to protest this application shall do so in accordance with Commission Rule No. 13 and Regulation No. 54-04(a), and any person wanting to comment on this matter, other than by protest, shall do so in writing, in accordance with Regulation No. 54-04(a), no later than Thursday, July 9, 1992, and shall simultaneously serve a copy of such protest or comment on applicant's representative, Sally A. Snead, Vice President, Cotter Limousine of Washington, Inc., 768 S. 23rd Street, Arlington, VA 22202.

4. That any person seeking a formal oral hearing on this matter shall request one, in writing, in accordance with Commission Regulation No. 54-04(b), no later than Thursday, July 9, 1992, and shall simultaneously serve a copy of such request on applicant's representative, Sally A. Snead, Vice President, Cotter Limousine of Washington, Inc., 768 S. 23rd Street, Arlington, VA 22202.
