By request filed July 22, 1992, WMATC Carrier No. 18 asks that the name on its Certificate of Authority be changed from Executive Limousine Service, Inc., to Executive Transportation Service, Inc. Applicant is a Virginia corporation. In support of its request, applicant shows that it has filed appropriate articles of amendment with the State Corporation Commission of Virginia and has been granted a certificate of amendment effecting the name change as described above.

This application is governed by the Compact, Title II, Article XI, Section 10(b). For good cause shown the request will be granted, and Certificate of Authority No. 18 will be reissued in the name of Executive Transportation Service, Inc., upon applicant's compliance with the requirements of this order.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the application to change the name on Certificate of Authority No. 18 to Executive Transportation Service, Inc., is hereby conditionally granted, contingent upon applicant's timely compliance with the requirements of this order.


2. That Executive Transportation Service, Inc., is hereby directed to file the following documents with the Commission within 30 days of the date of this order or such additional time as the Commission may direct or allow: (a) evidence of insurance pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 58 and Order No. 3623; (b) four copies of its General Tariff No. GT-2 cancelling GT-1, solely effecting the change of name; and (c) an affidavit that each vehicle to be operated pursuant to Certificate No. 18 has been identified with the name Executive Transportation Service, Inc. and WMATC No. 18, in accordance with the requirements of Regulation No. 61.

3. That upon timely compliance by Executive Transportation Service, Inc., with the requirements of the preceding paragraph and acceptance of the documents required by the Commission, Certificate of Authority No. 18 shall be reissued to Executive Transportation Service, Inc., 1104 Princess Street, Alexandria, VA 22314.

4. That unless Executive Transportation Service, Inc., complies with the requirements of this order within 30 days from the date of issuance, or such additional time as the Commission may direct

or allow, the grant of approval herein shall be void and the application shall stand denied in its entirety effective upon the expiration of said compliance time.
