
The certificate of insurance on file for Wheelchair Express, Inc. (WEI), was cancelled effective October 15, 1992. By Order No. 4010, served October 15, 1992, and incorporated herein by reference, WEI's Certificate of Authority No. 195 was suspended. This proceeding was instituted pursuant to the Compact, Title II, Article XI, Section 10 to determine whether Certificate No. 195 should be revoked. WEI was directed within 30 days to comply with Title II, Article XI, Section 7(f) of the Compact and Commission Regulation No. 58. WEI was further directed to file within the same 30-day period an appropriate certificate of insurance or other evidence to show good cause why Certificate of Authority No. 195 should not be revoked.

The time for submitting a new WMATC certificate of insurance or other pertinent evidence has elapsed without a filing of any type by WEI. Thus, pursuant to the authority of Title II, Article XI, Section 10 of the Compact, Certificate of Authority No. 195 will be revoked for failure to comply with both a lawful order and regulation of the Commission.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 195 of Wheelchair Express, Inc., is hereby revoked.
2. That Wheelchair Express, Inc., is hereby directed to remove from its vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61.
3. That Wheelchair Express, Inc., shall file with the Commission, within 30 days from the date of this order, a notarized affidavit that it has complied with the requirements of the preceding paragraph.
