By request filed November 18, 1992, WMATC carrier No. 213 asks that the name on its certificate of authority be changed from Clyde's Charter Bus Service, Inc., to Gunther Charters, Inc. Applicant is a Maryland corporation. In support of its request, applicant shows that it has filed appropriate articles of amendment with the Maryland State Department of Assessments and Taxation and has been issued a certificate of amendment effecting the name change as described above.

This application is governed by the Compact, Title II, Article XI, Section 10(b), which provides for amendment of a certificate of authority upon application of the holder. Most requests to amend a certificate are subject to the formal requirements of Commission Regulation No. 54.¹ Mere name change requests, such as the instant one, are not.² Accordingly, no application form or protest period will be required in this proceeding.

For good cause shown, the request will be granted, and Certificate of Authority No. 213 will be reissued in the name of Gunther Charters, Inc., upon applicant's timely compliance with the requirements of this order.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the application to change the name on Certificate of Authority No. 213 to Gunther Charters, Inc., is hereby conditionally granted, contingent upon applicant's timely compliance with the requirements of this order.

2. That Gunther Charters, Inc., is hereby directed to file the following documents with the Commission: (a) four copies of its General Tariff No. GT-2 cancelling GT-1, solely effecting the change of name; and (b) an affidavit that each vehicle to be operated pursuant to Certificate No. 213 has been identified with the name Gunther Charters, Inc., and WMATC No. 213, in accordance with the requirements of Regulation No. 61.



3. That upon timely compliance by Gunther Charters, Inc., with the requirements of the preceding paragraph and acceptance of the documents required by the Commission, Certificate of Authority No. 213 shall be reissued to Gunther Charters, Inc., 7474 Shipley Avenue, Hanover, MD 21076.

4. That unless Gunther Charters, Inc., complies with the requirements of this order within 30 days from the date of issuance, or such additional time as the Commission may direct or allow, the grant of approval herein shall be void and the application shall stand denied in its entirety effective upon the expiration of said compliance time.
