By application accepted for filing May 21, 1993, Manhattan International Transportation, Inc. (Manhattan or applicant), a Virginia corporation, seeks a certificate of authority to transport passengers, together with baggage in the same vehicles as passengers, in irregular route operations between points in the Metropolitan District.

Manhattan's application includes information regarding, among other things, its corporate status, equipment, facilities, safety fitness, proposed tariff, finances, and regulatory compliance record. The application is available for inspection at the office of the Commission during its regular business hours.

Manhattan proposes to commence operations with a 21-passenger minibus and a 15-passenger van. Applicant's proposed tariff contains hourly charter rates, with minimum fares for transfers and tours.

In determining whether to grant or deny an application for a certificate of authority, the Compact at Title II, Article XI, Section 7 requires that the Commission determine whether an applicant is fit, willing, and able to perform the transportation properly and conform to the provisions of the Compact and the Commission's rules, regulations, and requirements and whether the transportation is consistent with the public interest. Pursuant to Commission Rule No. 6, this order and fulfillment of its requirements will provide notice of Manhattan's application for a certificate of authority.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Manhattan International Transportation, Inc., shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than Thursday, June 3, 1993, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.


2. That Manhattan International Transportation, Inc., shall file with the Commission, no later than Thursday, June 24, 1993, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That any person wanting to protest the application, in accordance with Commission Rule No. 13 and Regulation No. 54-04(a), or comment on the application, in accordance with Regulation

No. 54-04(a), shall file such protest or comment at the office of the Commission, 1828 L Street, N.W., Suite 703, Washington, DC 20036-5104, no later than Thursday, June 24, 1993, and shall simultaneously serve a copy of such protest or comment on applicant's representative, Mr. Gregory F. Golubin, President, Manhattan International Transportation, Inc., 2500 Calvert Street, N.W., Washington, DC 20008.

4. That any person seeking a formal oral hearing on this matter, in accordance with Commission Regulation No. 54-04(b), shall request one no later than Thursday, June 24, 1993, and shall simultaneously serve a copy of such request on applicant's representative, Mr. Gregory F. Golubin, President, Manhattan International Transportation, Inc., 2500 Calvert Street, N.W., Washington, DC 20008.
