By Order No. 4097, served May 7, 1993, the above-captioned application was conditionally granted, contingent upon applicant timely filing certain documents specified in the order. One of the documents tendered for filing on May 26, 1993, showed applicant's name as Ramón Vicente Sam Martínez. Previously, all documents had been filed in the name of Ramón Sam, including the application which requires the full legal name of the applicant.

On May 27, 1993, the Commission's executive director wrote to applicant requesting applicant to verify his full legal name and provide supporting documentation. Applicant responded that his full legal name is Ramón Vicente Sam Martínez.

It appears, therefore, that notice of this application in the name of Ramón Sam was defective. The Commission will reopen this proceeding pursuant to Commission Rule No. 26-04 for the purpose of providing notice in applicant's full legal name.

As stated in Order No. 4073, served March 26, 1993, applicant seeks a certificate of authority to transport passengers, together with baggage in the same vehicles as passengers, in irregular route operations between points in the Metropolitan District, restricted to transportation in vehicles with a manufacturer's designed seating capacity of 15 or fewer persons, including the driver. Applicant proposes to commence operations with one twelve-passenger van. Applicant's proposed tariff contains per capita rates for service between DC and specified points in Montgomery and Prince George's counties in MD, on the one hand, and Washington Dulles International Airport, on the other. The proposed tariff also contains per capita rates between points in MD, and from points in Silver Spring, MD, to points in the District of Columbia.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Case No. AP-93-10 is hereby reopened on the Commission's initiative, and Order No. 4097, served May 7, 1993, is hereby stayed pending the outcome of revised notice as herein provided.


2. That Ramón Vicente Sam Martínez (Ramón Sam), trading as Maury's Express, shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than Friday, June 11, 1993, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

3. That Ramón Vicente Sam Martinez (Ramón Sam), trading as Maury's Express, shall file with the Commission, no later than Friday, July 2, 1993, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

4. That any person wanting to protest the application, in accordance with Commission Rule No. 13 and Regulation No. 54-04(a), or comment on the application, in accordance with Regulation No. 54-04(a), shall file such protest or comment at the office of the Commission, 1828 L Street, N.W., Suite 703, Washington, DC 20036-5104, no later than Friday, July 2, 1993, and shall simultaneously serve a copy of such protest or comment on applicant, Mr. Ramón V. Sam Martinez, trading as Maury's Express, 3000 Lancer Place, Hyattsville, MD 20782.

5. That any person seeking a formal oral hearing on this matter, in accordance with Commission Regulation No. 54-04(b), shall request one no later than Friday, July 2, 1993, and shall simultaneously serve a copy of such request on applicant, Mr. Ramón V. Sam Martinez, trading as Maury's Express, 3000 Lancer Place, Hyattsville, MD 20782.
