The certificate of insurance on file for Awards Transportation Services, Ltd. (ATS), expired effective May 1, 1993. By Order No. 4096, served May 3, 1993, and incorporated herein by reference, ATS's Certificate of Authority No. 174 was suspended. This proceeding was instituted pursuant to the Compact, Title II, Article XI, Section 10 to determine whether Certificate No. 174 should be revoked. ATS was directed within 30 days to comply with Title II, Article XI, Section 7(f) of the Compact and Commission Regulation No. 58. ATS was further directed to file within the same 30-day period an appropriate certificate of insurance or other evidence to show good cause why Certificate of Authority No. 174 should not be revoked.

The time for submitting a new WMATC certificate of insurance or other pertinent evidence has elapsed without a filing of any type by ATS. Thus, pursuant to the authority of Title II, Article XI, Section 10 of the Compact, Certificate of Authority No. 174 will be revoked for failure to comply with both a lawful order and regulation of the Commission.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 174 of Awards Transportation Services, Ltd., is hereby revoked.

2. That Awards Transportation Services, Ltd., is hereby directed to remove from its vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61.

3. That Awards Transportation Services, Ltd., shall file with the Commission, within 30 days from the date of this order, a notarized affidavit that it has complied with the requirements of the preceding paragraph.
