Marquis Limousine, Inc., holds Certificate of Authority No. 151 which authorizes transportation of passengers, together with their baggage in the same vehicles as passengers, in irregular route operations between points in the Metropolitan District.

By request filed September 14, 1993, Marquis Limousine, Inc., asks the Commission to terminate Certificate No. 151.

The Compact, Title II, Article XI, Section 10(b), provides:

Upon application by the holder of a certificate, the Commission may suspend, amend, or terminate the Certificate of Authority.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 151, issued to Marquis Limousine, Inc., is hereby terminated, effective this date.

2. That Marquis Limousine, Inc., shall remove from its vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61.

3. That Marquis Limousine, Inc., shall file with the Commission, within 30 days of the date of this order, a notarized affidavit stating that it has complied with the requirement of the preceding paragraph.
