Ruchman and Associates, Inc., trading as RAI, Inc., (RAI), holds Certificate of Authority No. 191, issued pursuant to Order No. 3844, served November 13, 1991. RAI's certificate authorizes transportation of passengers, together with mail in the same vehicles as passengers, in irregular route operations between points in the Metropolitan District. By request filed October 20, 1993, RAI asks the Commission to terminate Certificate No. 191.

The Compact, Title II, Article XI, Section 10(b), provides:

Upon application by the holder of a certificate, the Commission may suspend, amend, or terminate the Certificate of Authority.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 191, issued to Ruchman and Associates, Inc., trading as RAI, Inc., is hereby terminated, effective this date.

2. That Ruchman and Associates, Inc., trading as RAI, Inc., shall remove from its vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61.

3. That Ruchman and Associates, Inc., trading as RAI, Inc., shall file with the Commission, within 30 days of the date of this order, a notarized affidavit stating that it has complied with the requirement of the preceding paragraph.
