On March 15, 1994, DD Enterprises, Inc., trading as Beltway Transportation Service (Beltway), filed a contract tariff that did not meet the requirement of Regulation No. 55-08(c) that it "remain in effect for at least 60 days." Along with the contract tariff Beltway filed a request and justification for acceptance of the tariff.


The Compact, Title II, Article XI, Section 14(b)(i) provides that:

Each effective tariff shall remain in effect for at least 60 days from its effective date, unless the Commission orders otherwise,

For good cause shown, Beltway's request for waiver of Regulation No. 55-08(c) as it applies to Beltway's Contract Tariff No. CT-12 shall be granted, and the tariff shall be accepted for filing.
