This investigation was initiated in Order No. 4239 on January 13, 1994, and expanded in Order No. 4263 on March 25, 1994. The latter order directed Regency Services, Inc. (New Regency), to disclose certain information and produce certain documents by April 15, 1994.

On April 15, 1994, New Regency disclosed the requested information through its attorney and requested an additional seven days in which to produce the documents.

Commission Rule No. 7-05 provides that the Executive Director may grant a request for extension of time upon a showing of good cause. For good cause shown, the request for extension of time is approved. No further extensions will be granted.

Regency must comply with Order No. 4263 on or before April 22, 1994, by filing the manifests and invoices specified therein, plus an affidavit executed by New Regency verifying the factual representations in the April 15 request.¹

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Regency Services, Inc., shall comply with the requirements of Order No. 4263 on or before April 22, 1994.
