By request filed April 26, 1994, Carrier No. 198 (applicant) asks that the name on its certificate of authority be changed from Sky Lines, Inc., to Sky Lines Bus, Inc. Applicant is a Maryland corporation. Supporting the request is a copy of a notice issued by the State of Maryland, Department of Assessments and Taxation, advising applicant that its "articles of revival with a name change for Sky Lines, Inc. changing to Sky Lines Bus, Inc.," were received and approved.

This application is governed by the Compact, Title II, Article XI, Section 10(b).¹ For good cause shown, Certificate of Authority No. 198 will be reissued in the name of Sky Lines Bus, Inc., upon applicant's compliance with the requirements of this order.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the application to change the name on Certificate of Authority No. 198 to Sky Lines Bus, Inc., is hereby conditionally granted, contingent upon applicant's timely compliance with the requirements of this order.


2. That applicant is hereby directed to file the following documents with the Commission: (a) evidence of insurance pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 58 and Order No. 4203; (b) four copies of its General Tariff No. GT-3, cancelling No. GT-2, and omitting rates for service to/from BWI; (c) evidence of ownership or a lease as required by Commission Regulation No. 62 for each vehicle to be used in revenue operations; and (d) a notarized affidavit of identification of vehicles pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61.

3. That upon timely compliance with the requirements of the preceding paragraph and acceptance of the documents required by the Commission, Certificate of Authority No. 198 shall be reissued in the name of Sky Lines Bus, Inc.

4. That unless applicant complies with the requirements of this order within 30 days from the date of its issuance, or such additional time as the Commission may direct or allow, the grant of approval herein shall be void and the application shall stand denied in its entirety effective upon the expiration of said compliance time.
