The Metropolitan Washington Airports Authority currently charges taxicab operators a dispatch fee of \$1.00 for each trip originating at Washington National Airport. Under the interstate taxicab rates prescribed by this Commission, an operator who pays the dispatch fee in connection with an interstate trip between points in the Metropolitan District may add a surcharge of \$1.00 to the base fare for that trip, when carrying an individual or single preformed party.

The Airports Authority has increased the dispatch fee at National Airport from \$1.00 to \$1.25, effective July 1, 1994.


Pursuant to the Compact, Title II, Article XI, Section 18, and consistent with Order No. 1439, served June 20, 1975, and Order No. 3506, served May 22, 1990, the aforementioned surcharge shall be increased to \$1.25.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the interstate rates for taxicab service within the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit District are hereby amended to include a surcharge of \$1.25 for each interstate taxicab trip originating at Washington National Airport; provided that the surcharge may be applied only if: (a) the operator is carrying an individual or single preformed party, and (b) the operator has paid the \$1.25 taxicab dispatch fee for the trip to which the surcharge is applied.

2. That the amendment prescribed herein shall become effective July 1, 1994.
