
The Compact, Title II, Article XI, Section 10(b), provides:

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 172, issued to United Management Corporation, trading as Passenger Express, is hereby terminated, effective this date.
2. That United Management Corporation, trading as Passenger Express, shall remove from its vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61.
3. That United Management Corporation, trading as Passenger Express, shall file with the Commission, within 30 days of the date of this order, a notarized affidavit stating that it has complied with the requirement of the preceding paragraph.
