This investigation was initiated on July 15, 1994, in Order No. 4344 (initial order) for the purpose of determining whether Certificate of Authority No. 49 issued to Ellis B. Harrison, trading as Area Transportation (respondent), shall be revoked for respondent's willful failure to comply with the insurance provisions of the Compact and regulations thereunder.

The Compact, Title II, Article XI, Section 7(f), directs each person holding a certificate of authority to comply with the Commission's insurance regulations. Commission Regulation No. 58-01 requires each carrier to maintain on file with the Commission an effective certificate of insurance.

Respondent's certificate of insurance for primary coverage expired 12:01 a.m. on July 14, 1994, triggering the invalidation and automatic suspension of respondent's certificate of authority under Article XI, Section 7(g), of the Compact and Regulation No. 58-02. Respondent was directed to file within 30 days from the date of the initial order an appropriate certificate of insurance or other evidence showing good cause why its certificate of authority should not be revoked. To date, respondent has filed neither.

On July 15, 1994, the Commission received notice of cancellation of respondent's certificate of insurance for excess coverage, effective August 14, 1994.

Respondent's certificate of authority shall be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact for respondent's willful failure to comply with the insurance provisions of the Compact, the regulations thereunder and the initial order in this proceeding.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 49 issued to Ellis B. Harrison, trading as Area Transportation, is hereby revoked.

2. That Ellis B. Harrison, trading as Area Transportation, is hereby directed to remove from its vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61.

3. That Ellis B. Harrison, trading as Area Transportation, is hereby directed to file within 30 days from the date of this order a notarized affidavit verifying that respondent has complied with the preceding paragraph.
