This application was conditionally approved in Order No. 4356, served August 2, 1994, contingent on applicant filing certain documents by September 1, 1994.


Presently outstanding are a series of requests for extension of the September 1 compliance deadline. The latest seeks to extend the deadline to January 11, 1995. Under Commission Regulation No. 66, "[t]he time for compliance with the requirements for a conditional grant of authority will not be extended beyond a maximum of 180 days from the date the conditional grant of authority is issued." The latest date for compliance in this case is January 29, 1995. The compliance deadline shall be extended until then, subject to the following conditions.

According to an affidavit filed September 9, 1994, applicant's vehicles presently display the WMATC number assigned in Order No. 4356. Applicant will be directed to file an affidavit verifying that all such markings have been concealed or removed pending completion of applicant's compliance with Order No. 4356. At the appropriate time, applicant shall submit a new affidavit of vehicle identification evidencing compliance with Regulation No. 61.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall comply with the requirements of Order No. 4356 on or before January 29, 1995.
2. That applicant shall file within ten (10) days of the date of this order an affidavit verifying that all markings on applicant's vehicles which indicate applicant possesses WMATC operating authority have been concealed or removed pending completion of applicant's compliance with Order No. 4356.
3. That applicant shall file a new affidavit of identification of vehicles in accordance with Commission Regulation No. 61 at such time as the Commission's Executive Director shall hereafter specify, but no later than January 29, 1995.
