By application accepted for filing January 24, 1995, HMC Acquisition Properties, Inc., a Delaware corporation trading as Westfields International Conference Center by Marriott, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in the Metropolitan District in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.


Applicant proposes commencing operations with eight 8-passenger vehicles. Applicant's proposed tariff contains one-way per capita rates for service between the Conference Center, on the one hand, and points in DC, Montgomery County and Prince George's County, on the other. The application is available for inspection at the office of the Commission during its regular business hours.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than February 10, 1995, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.
2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than March 3, 1995, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.
3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is March 3, 1995, and that copies must be served on applicant's Controller, Michael Kelly, 14750 Conference Center Drive, Chantilly, VA 22021.
