By application accepted for filing February 1, 1995, Reston Limousine & Travel Service, Inc., a Virginia corporation trading as Reston Limousine, requests removal of the 15-passenger restriction in Certificate of Authority No. 241. Applicant also requests authority to transport baggage in the same vehicles as passengers.

The application includes information regarding, among other things, applicant's corporate status, carrier affiliations, facilities, proposed tariff, and regulatory compliance record. The application is available for inspection at the office of the Commission during its regular business hours.

Applicant proposes adding a 25-passenger minibus. Applicant's proposed tariff contains hourly rates, with minimum charges, for service in sedans, limousines, vans and minibuses.

The Commission may amend a certificate of authority upon application by the holder.<sup>1</sup> A carrier seeking expanded operating authority must make the showing required of an applicant for a new certificate.<sup>2</sup> Accordingly, this proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.<sup>3</sup>

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than February 13, 1995, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.
2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than March 6, 1995, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.
