By application filed March 10, 1995, Nathaniel Montgomery, a sole proprietor trading as Corporate Wheels, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in the Metropolitan District in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver. The application is available for inspection at the office of the Commission during its regular business hours.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with a 5-passenger vehicle. Applicant's proposed tariff contains flat rates for service between specified points in Maryland, Virginia and DC, on the one hand, and downtown DC, National Airport, Dulles Airport and BWI Airport, on the other. The proposed tariff, however, does not state whether the rates apply on a per capita basis or group basis, and the BWI rates and intra-Virginia rates apply to service outside the Commission's jurisdiction. Applicant will be directed to file an amended proposed tariff omitting the BWI rates, omitting the rates for service between National and Dulles Airports, on the one hand, and points in Virginia, on the other, and stating whether the proposed rates apply on a per person basis or group basis.

In addition, applicant has not requested authority to transport baggage in the same vehicles as passengers even though airport passengers normally carry luggage. Applicant will be directed to file a statement expressly requesting or declining baggage authority.

Finally, the only assets listed by applicant in his statement of net worth are cash, home and auto. Applicant will be directed to file an amended statement of net worth listing all assets and associated debts.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than April 7, 1995, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.

2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than April 28, 1995, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.


3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than April 7, 1995, an original and four copies of an amended proposed tariff omitting the BWI rates, omitting the rates for service between National and Dulles Airports, on the one hand, and points in Virginia, on the other, and stating whether the proposed rates apply on a per person basis or group basis.

4. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than April 7, 1995, an original and four copies of a statement expressly requesting or declining baggage authority.

5. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than April 7, 1995, an original and four copies of an amended statement of net worth listing all assets and associated debts.

6. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is April 28, 1995, and that copies must be served on applicant at 2431 Dorchester Road, Upper Marlboro, MD 20772.
