
This proceeding was initiated in Order No. 4514, served March 7, 1995, as a result of respondent's failure to timely file its annual report for 1994. That order granted respondent thirty days to file said annual report and either pay a civil forfeiture of \$50 or show cause why a civil forfeiture should not be assessed. The order further provided that failure to timely comply would result automatically in suspension of respondent's operating authority.

On April 7, 1995, respondent submitted a request for extension of time to comply with Order No. 4514. Respondent simultaneously tendered said annual report and \$50.

For good cause shown, the request for extension of time is granted and this proceeding is terminated.
