By application filed March 31, 1995, Barrett's Metropolitan Transport, Inc., a Maryland corporation trading as BMT Transit, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in the Metropolitan District in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver. The application is available for inspection at the office of the Commission during its regular business hours.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with two vans. Applicant's proposed tariff contains mileage rates, including rates for wheelchair passengers and airport passengers.

Applicant's projected operating statement, Exhibit G, states that applicant plans to inject \$23,000 into BMT. Applicant's balance sheet, Exhibit E, indicates that BMT already has \$23,000 cash on hand. Applicant will be directed to file a statement expressly confirming that the \$23,000 cash listed in Exhibit E has actually been deposited in applicant's bank account.


This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than April 21, 1995, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.
2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than May 12, 1995, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.
3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than April 21, 1995, an original and four copies of a statement expressly confirming that the \$23,000 cash listed in Exhibit E has actually been deposited in applicant's bank account.

4. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is May 12, 1995, and that copies must be served on applicant's President, Mr. Cecil G. Barrett, 2403 Ewing Avenue, Suitland, MD 20746.
