By application filed April 5, 1995, Escort Transport Inc., a Maryland corporation, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in the Metropolitan District. The application is available for inspection at the office of the Commission during its regular business hours.


Applicant proposes commencing operations with one minibus. Applicant's proposed tariff contains an hourly charter rate with a minimum charge.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than April 12, 1995, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.
2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than May 21, 1995, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.
3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is May 21, 1995, and that copies must be served on applicant's president, Mr. Henry Twisdale, 2513 Olson Street, Temple Hills, MD 20748.
