
This proceeding was initiated in Order No. 4514, served March 7, 1995, as a result of respondent's failure to timely file an annual report for 1994. Order No. 4514 granted respondent thirty days to file the annual report and either pay a civil forfeiture of \$50 or show cause why a civil forfeiture should not be assessed. The order further provided that failure to timely comply would result automatically in suspension of respondent's operating authority.

Respondent failed to timely comply with Orders No. 4514, thus triggering the automatic suspension of respondent's operating authority at 12:01 a.m., April 7, 1995.

On April 17, 1995, respondent filed its annual report and paid a civil forfeiture of \$50. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this proceeding as hereby terminated.
