This investigation was initiated in Order No. 4480, served January 24, 1995. Respondent was ordered to show cause by February 23, 1995, why a civil forfeiture should not be assessed with respect to its operations in the Metropolitan District in October and November of 1994, as evidenced by respondent's driver logs, which the Commission obtained from the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) pursuant to a cooperative agreement under Public Law No. 89-170. Any request for oral hearing was to be filed by February 8, 1995.


On February 17, 1995, respondent filed a response stating as grounds for termination of the investigation that any violations were inadvertent and requesting an oral hearing should the matter go forward.

For good cause shown, respondent's late-filed request for oral hearing shall be granted. Pursuant to the Compact, Article XIV, Section 1, respondent shall be assessed estimated hearing expenses.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That respondent shall appear at a hearing to be held in the hearing room of the Commission at 1828 L Street, N.W., Suite 703, Washington, DC.
2. That said hearing shall commence at 10:00 a.m., on May 31, 1995, and continue until adjourned.
3. That on or before May 18, 1995, respondent shall remit to the Commission the sum of \$400 to cover estimated hearing expenses.
