By application filed May 1, 1995, Bach Vu, a sole proprietor trading as Affordable Airport Charter, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in the Metropolitan District in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver. Applicant's previous application for operating authority was dismissed for want of prosecution.¹


Applicant proposes commencing operations in a van with a seating capacity of six persons. Applicant's proposed tariff contains per-capita rates for service between National and Dulles Airports, on the one hand, and points in Montgomery and Prince George's Counties, on the other. The application is available for inspection at the office of the Commission during its regular business hours.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than May 22, 1995, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.
2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than June 12, 1995, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.
3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is June 12, 1995, and that copies must be served on applicant at 18725 Mooney Drive, Gaithersburg, MD 20879.
