By application filed July 6, 1995, Omer A. Tarig, trading as Skycare Trans, a sole proprietor, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.


Applicant proposes commencing operations with two vans. Applicant's proposed tariff contains per capita rates and group rates for transportation of disabled passengers, including transportation under the DC Medicaid program.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than July 21, 1995, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.
2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than August 11, 1995, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.
3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is August 11, 1995, and that copies must be served on applicant at 477 N. Armistead Street, #14, Alexandria, VA 22312.
