By application accepted for filing August 30, 1995, Green's Transportation Company, Inc., a Maryland corporation, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in the Metropolitan District.


Applicant proposes commencing operations with one van. Applicant's proposed tariff contains group charter rates and per capita rates for transportation of Medicaid recipients.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than September 11, 1995, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.
2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than October 2, 1995, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.
3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is October 2, 1995, and that copies must be served on applicant's president, Elaine V. Green, 4111 Kilbourne Drive, Fort Washington, MD 20744.
