
By application accepted for filing August 23, 1995, Assisted Transportation, Inc., a Maryland corporation, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Notice of this application was served on August 24, 1995, in Order No. 4651, and applicant was directed to publish further notice in a newspaper no later than September 5, 1995. On September 25, 1995, applicant advised the Commission that said notice was not timely published. Accordingly, a new publication deadline shall be established.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than October 6, 1995, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.
2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than October 27, 1995, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.
3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is October 27, 1995, and that copies must be served on applicant's president, Mr. John T. Allen, Jr., 9800 Broad Street, Bethesda, MD 20814.
