

On August 28, 1995, in Order No. 4652, the Commission found Greyhound Lines, Inc. (GLI), was not in compliance with the terms of its \$5 million self-insurance authorization and had not filed evidence of insurance for the first \$1.5 million in BI&PD liability, as required by Commission Regulation No. 58. The Commission directed GLI to file a certificate of insurance for the first \$1.5 million in BI&PD liability or evidence of compliance with the terms of its self-insurance authorization, or show cause why Certificate of Authority No. 139 should not be revoked.

On October 2, 1995, GLI filed a certificate of insurance for \$5 million in primary coverage, thereby complying with Order No. 4652 and Regulation No. 58. Accordingly, the show-cause order is lifted, effective October 2, 1995.
