
By application filed October 4, 1995, Hubert Rawls Nicholson, trading as Holiday Tours, requests removal of the 15-passenger restriction in Certificate of Authority No. 221. Applicant proposes adding a 47-passenger motorcoach and charging the same per capita rates as those currently on file in applicant's General Tariff No. GT-2.

Under Article XI, Section 10(b), of the Compact, the Commission may amend a certificate of authority upon application by the holder. A carrier seeking expanded operating authority must show that it is fit and that the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.¹ This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed amendment is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than October 16, 1995, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.
2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than November 6, 1995, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.
3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is November 6, 1995, and that copies must be served on applicant at 7308 High Bridge Road, Bowie, MD 20715.
