By application accepted for filing October 27, 1995, Valerie Alleyne, a sole proprietor trading as Alleyne's Transportation Services, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.


Applicant proposes commencing operations with one van. Applicant's proposed tariff contains individual and group rates for transportation between Washington National Airport and Washington-Dulles International Airport, on the one hand, and, on the other, points in the Metropolitan District.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than November 10, 1995, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.
2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than December 1, 1995, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.
3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is December 1, 1995, and that copies must be served on applicant's representative Lennox Alleyne, 6608 Greenvale Parkway, Riverdale, MD 20737.
