By application accepted for filing November 1, 1995, Capitol Bus Rental, Inc., a District of Columbia corporation trading as Capitol Tours, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in the Metropolitan District.


Applicant proposes commencing operations with fourteen motorcoaches. Applicant's proposed tariff contains hourly rates and transfer rates.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than November 13, 1995, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.
2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than December 4, 1995, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.
3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is December 4, 1995, and that copies must be served on applicant's president, Luther L. Perkins, 5925 New Hampshire Avenue, N.E., Washington, DC 20011.
