
The application to transfer Certificate of Authority No. 209 was conditionally approved in Order No. 4715 on December 5, 1995, contingent on transferee filing certain documents within thirty days. On January 30, 1996, transferee requested an extension of the filing deadline.

Certificate No. 209 has been suspended since April 8, 1995.¹ Commission Regulation No. 65 states that if a certificate of authority remains suspended for 365 consecutive days, it "shall be deemed terminated and revoked effective on the 366th day."

For good cause shown, and in consideration of Regulation No. 65, the filing deadline shall be extended through April 5, 1996. No further extensions will be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, that transferee shall comply with the requirements of Order No. 4715 on or before April 5, 1996.

¹ Transferor's certificate of insurance was revoked in Order No. 4517 issued March 9, 1995, effective April 8, 1995. Because transferor did not file a replacement certificate of insurance, Certificate of Authority No. 209 was deemed automatically suspended on April 8, 1995, pursuant to Regulation No. 58-02.
