By application filed March 27, 1996, O. Oluokun, Inc., a Maryland corporation trading as Montgomery County Limo and Montgomery County Shuttle, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant was conditionally granted operating authority in 1992, but applicant failed to timely satisfy the conditions, and the application was deemed denied.¹ Applicant subsequently was assessed a civil forfeiture for operating in knowing and willful violation of the Compact.² Applicant paid the forfeiture in full.

Applicant's proposed tariff contains airport transfer rates, hourly charter rates, per capita shuttle rates and per capita mileage rates.

Applicant's equipment list shows two sedans. Applicant's proposed tariff, on the other hand, states that the hourly charter rates apply to limousines, as well, and applicant's Exhibit A indicates that applicant also operates vans and buses. Applicant will be directed to file a statement explaining which of these vehicle types it intends to operate under a WMATC certificate of authority, plus a conforming equipment list and a conforming proposed tariff.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than April 12, 1996, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.


2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than May 3, 1996, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.

3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than April 12, 1996, an original and four copies of a statement explaining which of the following vehicle types it intends to operate under a WMATC certificate of authority: sedans, limousines, vans, buses.

4. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than April 12, 1996, an original and four copies of an amended equipment list and an amended proposed tariff, conforming to the statement filed in response to the preceding paragraph.

5. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is May 3, 1996, and that copies must be served on applicant's president, Mr. Charlie Oluokun, P.O. Box 395, Greenbelt, MD 20768-0395.
