
By Order No. 4778, served February 27, 1996, the Commission revoked Certificate of Authority No. 214 pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact for respondent's willful failure to maintain on file with the Commission an effective certificate of insurance. On March 28, 1996, respondent filed an application for reconsideration.

Under Title II of the Compact, Article XIII, Section 4(a), an application for reconsideration must state specifically the errors claimed as grounds for reconsideration. Respondent's application does not allege any error on the part of the Commission. The application therefore is denied.

However, considering that respondent has filed a new certificate of insurance showing continuous coverage since the cancellation of the previous certificate of insurance, we will reopen this proceeding on our own initiative and reinstate Certificate of Authority No. 214.¹
