
By application accepted for filing March 27, 1996, Chika Transport Service, Inc., a District of Columbia corporation, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Notice of this application was served on April 1, 1996, in Order No. 4804, and applicant was directed to publish further notice in a newspaper no later than April 12, 1996. On May 8, 1996, applicant advised the Commission that said notice was not timely published. Accordingly, a new publication deadline shall be established.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than May 17, 1996, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.
2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than June 7, 1996, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.
3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is June 7, 1996, and that copies must be served on applicant's representative, Gary T. Williams, 1899 L Street, N.W., Suite 500, Washington, DC 20036.
