By application accepted for filing June 11, 1996, Ira A. Austin, Sr., a sole proprietor trading as Ira's Transportation Service, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.


Applicant proposes commencing operations with one van. Applicant's proposed tariff contains individual roundtrip rates, including rates for transportation to and from bingo halls.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than June 25, 1996, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.
2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than July 16, 1996, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.
3. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is July 16, 1996, and that copies must be served on applicant at 330 Missouri Avenue, N.W., Washington, DC 20011.
