On April 2, 1996, in Order No. 4806, the Commission ordered Presidential Coach to submit, on or before April 29, 1996, proof that Presidential Coach's Articles of Dissolution have been received and accepted by the DC Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs. On May 9, 1996, in Order No. 4833, the Commission ordered All-Star Presidential and its members to submit, on or before May 24, 1996, information on any vehicles and passenger carrier authority held by All-Star and its members. Since then, the Commission has received various requests for extensions of both filing deadlines. This order grants an extension of both deadlines through August 30, 1996, and provides that no further extensions will be granted.

**I. Order No. 4806**

On June 26, 1996, Presidential Coach requested a thirty-day extension of the April 29 deadline for submitting proof that its Articles of Dissolution have been received and accepted by the DC Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs. On July 11, 1996, Presidential Coach requested a further extension to August 30, 1996. An extension shall be granted through August 30. No further extension will be granted.

**II. Order No. 4833**

On May 31, respondents requested a ten-day extension of the May 24 deadline for submitting information on any vehicles and passenger carrier authority held by All-Star and its members. That request was granted May 31 in Order No. 4864.


On June 18, 1996, All-Star filed an unnotarized statement explaining that it was "formed only for the purpose of purchasing and owning real estate." As noted in Order No. 4833, All-Star's Articles of Organization and Operating Agreement contradict that assertion.

On June 26, All-Star requested an extension of thirty days. On July 11, All-Star requested a further extension to August 30, 1996. Although this latest request refers to certain leases addressed in Order No. 4806, not Order No. 4833, All-Star and its members shall have until August 30 to comply with Order No. 4833. No further extension will be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Presidential Coach shall comply with the requirements of Order No. 4806 on or before August 30, 1996.
2. That All-Star and its members shall comply with the requirements of Order No. 4833 on or before August 30, 1996.
3. That no further extensions will be granted.
