By application filed August 30, 1996, Fast Track Medical Transportation Inc., a Maryland corporation, seeks a certificate of authority for irregular route operations in vehicles with a seating capacity of less than 16 persons only, including the driver.

Applicant proposes commencing operations with one van. Applicant proposes transporting the elderly and disabled to and from medical clinics and other locations.


Exhibit D to the application, applicant's proposed rates, has been omitted. Applicant will be directed to file an Exhibit D containing applicant's proposed rates.

This proceeding is hereby initiated to determine whether applicant is fit and whether the proposed transportation is consistent with the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That applicant shall publish once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District, no later than September 16, 1996, notice in the form prescribed by the staff of the Commission.
2. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than October 7, 1996, an original and four copies of an affidavit that notice has been published as required in the preceding paragraph.
3. That applicant shall file with the Commission, no later than September 16, 1996, an original and four copies of an Exhibit D containing applicant's proposed rates.
4. That the deadline for filing protests, comments, applications for intervention, and requests for formal hearing, is October 7, 1996, and that copies must be served on applicant's president, Ms. Rona Sherzai, 24033 Glade Valley Terrace, Damascus, MD 20872.
