By application filed October 10, 1996, WMATC Carrier No. 157 requests that the name on its certificate of authority be changed from ATE Management and Service Company, Inc., to Ryder/ATE, Inc.

Applicant is a Delaware corporation. In support of its request, applicant has filed a certificate of ownership displaying the name change, as certified by the Delaware Secretary of State. Evidence of insurance has been filed in the new corporate name.

Under Article XI, Section 10(b), of the Compact, the Commission may amend a certificate of authority upon application by the holder. Simple name change requests may be granted on good cause shown.¹

For good cause shown, the application will be granted, and Certificate of Authority No. 157 will be reissued in the name of Ryder/ATE, Inc., upon applicant's timely compliance with the requirements of this order.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the application to change the name on Certificate of Authority No. 157 to Ryder/ATE, Inc., is hereby conditionally granted, contingent upon applicant's timely compliance with the requirements of this order.


2. That applicant is hereby directed to file the following documents with the Commission: (a) an equipment list stating the year, make, model, serial number, vehicle number, license plate number (with jurisdiction) and seating capacity of each vehicle to be used in revenue operations; (b) evidence of ownership or a lease as required by Commission Regulation No. 62 for each vehicle to be used in revenue operations; (c) proof of current safety inspection of said vehicle(s) by or on behalf of the United States Department of Transportation, the State of Maryland, the District of Columbia, or the Commonwealth of Virginia; and (d) a notarized affidavit of identification of vehicles pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61, for which purpose WMATC No. 157 is hereby reassigned.

3. That upon timely compliance with the requirements of the preceding paragraph and acceptance of the documents required by the Commission, Certificate of Authority No. 157 shall be reissued to Ryder/ATE, Inc., 49 East 4th Street, Suite 700, Cincinnati, OH 45202.

4. That unless applicant complies with the requirements of this order within 30 days from the date of its issuance, or such additional time as the Commission may direct or allow, the conditional grant herein shall be void and the application shall stand denied in its entirety effective upon the expiration of said compliance time.
