
The Compact, Title II, Article XI, Section 10(b), provides:

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 181, issued to B&J Transportation, Inc., is hereby terminated, effective this date.
2. That B&J Transportation, Inc., shall remove from its vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61.
3. That B&J Transportation, Inc., shall file with the Commission, within 30 days of the date of this order, a notarized affidavit stating that it has complied with the requirement of the preceding paragraph.
