

The application of Washington Shuttle, Inc., trading as SuperShuttle, was conditionally granted in Order No. 4966, served November 8, 1996, contingent on applicant filing certain documents on or before December 8, 1996. Applicant has requested a 30-day extension of time to complete the process of marking its vehicles in accordance with Regulation No. 61, which under Order No. 4966 must be verified by affidavit.

Commission Rule No. 7-05 provides that the Executive Director may grant a request for extension of time for good cause shown. The request was filed December 6, 1996, and applicant has since filed all documents required by Order No. 4966, including the affidavit verifying compliance with Regulation No. 61. The request is unopposed.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that for good cause shown, applicant's request for extension of time is hereby granted.
